WHAT?

National Grid is proposing substation upgrades at the existing Bell Rock Substation, including reconfiguration and expansion of the substation footprint, to accommodate new equipment like switches and circuit breakers, installation of a new 43 x 66-foot control building, and new perimeter fencing.

WHO?

National Grid is planning to invest approximately \$16M in Fall River, MA to rebuild the Bell Rock Substation.

WHERE?

The Bell Rock Substation is located at 181 Bell Rock Road in Fall River, Massachusetts.

WHY?

The Bell Rock Substation will be upgraded and expanded to improve the reliability and operability of the substation, and to accommodate the termination of the existing M13 115 kilovolt (kV) transmission line into the substation.

MAP OF PROPOSED PROJECT


WHEN?

Pending regulatory approvals, construction will begin in 2020 and the substation will be commissioned in mid-2021.
